We are so faithful to this platform, that we come together in user groups, go to MacWorld or attend Macintosh themed cruise vacations.




Call to Order: 6:52 p.m. by President, Phil Booth, who requested Jim Connell to take minutes of the meeting in the absence of Secretary Lyda McGhee.

General Announcements/General Meeting Recap: No announcements or general meeting recap.

REPORTS:

Secretary: The minutes of the board meeting held on October 3, 2006, were approved with one amendment. The amendment, which is to the beginning of the membership report, reads as follows: "In September one new member joined HAAUG, and ten members renewed their membership."

Treasurer – Barbara Long: HAAUG has money in the bank. The current bank balance is \$13, 390.96. HAAUG has a preliminary loss year-to-date of \$417.64. All bills presented have been paid.
