





Treasurer – Barbara Long: The financial reports for April have not been prepared because the final figures and Kagi report for April are not yet available. The reports will be sent out as soon when the information for April has been received. HAAUG has money in the bank.

Rex Covington suggested that HAAUG have a series of new tshirts designed for sale on Café Press.

Dwight Silverman has mentioned in his blog that he will be speaking at the May General Meeting. The board discussed ways of accommodating a large crowd at the May General Meeting. Doug suggested testing the iChatAV software at the Rice University Media Center at this month's General Meeting to make sure it works satisfactorily in advance of the June General Meeting. Doug reported that there is still a demand for the Lake Jackson SIG and he is looking for another venue for the SIG, in the event Bookends closes.

2nd Vice President – Mike Miron: The structure in the middle of the Gallery at Rice University Media Center may still be in place at the time of this month's General Meeting, and it is possible that the structure may be a permanent fixture.

New/Old Business: Doug Smith and Tamara Alexander will be set up to send out by email the monthly announcement and the Apple Barrel. Rex Covington suggested establishing a set day (such as Tuesday) prior to the General Meeting to send out the monthly announcement.

Macfest 2007: The Shamrock Room at the Hilton University of Houston Hotel has been reserved for Saturday, September 29. Phil Booth requested Rex Covington to obtain written confirmation from the three speakers (Chris Breen, Andy Ihnatko and Bob LeVitus) that have agreed to make presentations at Macfest 2007. The Macfest Committee will meet later this month.
