




# Cool Stuff You Can Do With OS X Terminal

The December Meeting will feature Lee Hutchinson of Ars Technica, This will be a second appearance of Lee and the topic looks interesting. If you are a Unix geek he will explore Terminal commands.

There are two important issues that the HAAUG Board will bring to the membership at the December meeting. First will be the slate of officers that the membership will need to approve. HAAUG Board of Directors Meeting - October 18, 2014

**Location:** Embassy Suites, 2911 Sage Road, Houston, Texas (temporary meeting location)

**Attendees:** Philip Booth, David Jaschke, Clair Jaschke, Jack Adair, Mike Epstein, Mike King, Greg Wright, Alán Alán Apurim (guest)

**Call to Order:** By President Philip Booth at 12:52 PM following the conclusion of the October General Meeting.

**General Announcements:** Phil appreciates everyone's efforts in making this meeting successful. We had pretty good attendance considering the venue change. We saved some money in sodas and bottled water at the last minute. We can start putting up speakers at the Embassy Suites as they provide free breakfast.

#### **Monthly Reports**

**Secretary - Clair Jaschke (for Jack Adair):** Minutes of the August and September BOD meetings were approved unanimously.

**Treasurer's Report - Clair Jaschke:** Our checking account balance as of the end of September was \$5660.85. Our savings account balance was \$10,000.59, for a total cash on hand of \$15,661.44. We earned \$.05 interest on the checking account and \$0.26 on the savings account. All of the September bills have been paid.

Clair thanked the board for the approval of the new version of AccountEdge, which cost \$159.00. We also got a letter from Chase Bank indicating that our checking account will be updated, but there is no change that we will see.

**Vice President - Greg Wright:** Chris Breen is confirmed, but it will be by video instead of in-person due to his new position with Macworld.

Greg is still trying to get Dave Hamilton for December. Things fell through two days before the meeting in that Dave was unable to get fully prepared and asked to cancel. Greg will try to get him here physically. The December meeting will be on December 13. The next two meetings will be the Swap Meet in January and Bob LeVitus in February.

Phil indicated that he would try to resurrect the Photo SIG in November, probably at 9 AM.

**Membership - David Jaschke:** Dave reported that we ended the month of September with 153 members, which is down by two from 155 members from August, and down from 166 members (a difference of 13 members) from September 30, 2013. We had only 2 renewals in September, one by KAGI and

one at the September meeting.

**HAAUG Electronic Communications Systems:** Ryan was absent due to a conflict this month. He has created a template for the Apple Barrel in InDesign. Phil will get him an article in a week or so. Deadline for submissions will continue to be the first Saturday of the month. He has met with Tamara to collaborate on electronic issues.

#### **New Business**

**2015 Budget Committee:** Phil, Clair, and Mike King will comprise the 2015 Budget Committee. The budget has to be approved by the Board by the December board meeting and approved by the membership at the January Swap Meet.

Alán Alán Apurim indicated a general concern that we needed a better cross-section of age and cultural diversity in the membership of HAAUG, particularly in advertising to universities and discussing the advantages of face to face discussions. Phil indicated that he had gotten a recent call asking for help about setting up files on a new computer: he indicated that he had referred the person to either MacExperts or an Apple Genius. We really have no traction with the Apple Store on any user group related issues, but we might have a better shot with Micro Center.
