

BOD Minutes

December 19, 2015

Location: Bellaire Civic Center, 7008 South Rice Avenue, Bellaire, Texas

Attendees: Phil Booth, David Jaschke, Clair Jaschke, Jack Adair, Mike King, Mike Epstein, Ryan Eisworth, Steve Bridgham

Call to Order: By President Phil Booth at 12:09 PM following the conclusion of the December General Meeting.

General Announcements: Phil is off work next week and will interface with the folks from the City of Bellaire on Monday to discuss 2016 meeting arrangements.

2016 Board of Directors Nomination and Approval

Prior to the beginning of Doug Smith's holiday shopping presentation, the membership voted on the 2016 Board of Directors nominations. The vote was called from a motion by Doug Smith, and a second by Rick Roberts. The nominees were:

President: Phil Booth Vice-President: Steve Bridgham

- Secretary: Jack E. Adair
- Treasurer: Clair Jaschke
- Membership Chairman: Dave Jaschke

Media and Communications Coordinator: Ryan Eisworth Members at Large: Mike King, Mike Epstein

The nominees were approved by voice vote of the membership, and therefore constitute the 2016 HAAUG Board of Directors.

Monthly Reports

Secretary - Jack Adair: Amended minutes of the November BOD meeting were approved unanimously. The original minutes sent out had to be amended due to an error on the location of the meeting venue.

Treasurer's Report - Clair Jaschke: Clair reported that our checking account balance as of the end of November was \$3,849.00. Our savings account balance was \$10,002.90, for total cash on hand of \$13,851.90. All bills have been paid except the bill from Embassy Suites; this bill will clear this month. All monies have deposited.

Dave Jaschke moved that we purchase the new version of Account Edge 2016 for \$159.00. This motion was seconded by Mike King, and the motion passed unanimously.

Membership - David Jaschke: Dave reported that we ended the month of November with 137 members, which down by one from October, and down from 150 members (a difference of 13 members) from November 30, 2014. We had very good activity

for November with a total of thirteen transactions. We had five new members join and one lapsed member renew. In addition, we had three two-year renewals and four regular renewals. Of these transactions, we had four by credit card and two were made using KAGI. All in all, it was a very good month. Bob LeVitus' appearance was a big factor in the new membership activity.

Programming Report: We have a new VP of programming, Steve Bridgham.

Phil will talk to the City of Bellaire on Monday to discuss the 2016 meeting locations. We had previously been offered the pool house as an alternate location. Phil said he would send out a full report to the Board once he talks with the city. Next month will be the Swap Meet.

Phil is interested in having a Main Presentation workshop at some time outside the normal monthly Board meeting to work out a schedule for 2016. Ryan suggested that this be done after the survey on topics he is preparing to send out. Once we get these results, we can possibly discuss what we want to do after the Swap Meet.

HAAUG Electronic Communications Systems - Ryan Eisworth:

Ryan indicated that we have acknowledged that there is a problem with the mailing lists, and that we are working on resolving it. The problem was with our hosting provider, but the resolution is uncertain at the current time.

We are looking at going to Mail Chimp; Ryan has set up a new account for HAAUG.

Old Business

2016 Budget: Clair presented the revised budget. This budget presumes that we will continue to meet at a Bellaire site, as opposed to going off site at Embassy Suites. The budget shows a slight projected loss for 2016, but we have the funds to cover the budget. Dave Jaschke moved that we accept the budget, and Ryan Eisworth seconded. The board voted to approve the budget, and it now goes to the membership for approval in the January meeting.

New Business

Proposed Survey: Ryan presented some discussion questions for the membership survey, and the board discussed these suggestions. We will specifically ask about impressions on each of the main presentations, including the Swap Meets, for 2015. There is also consideration about how-to questions regarding specific products.
