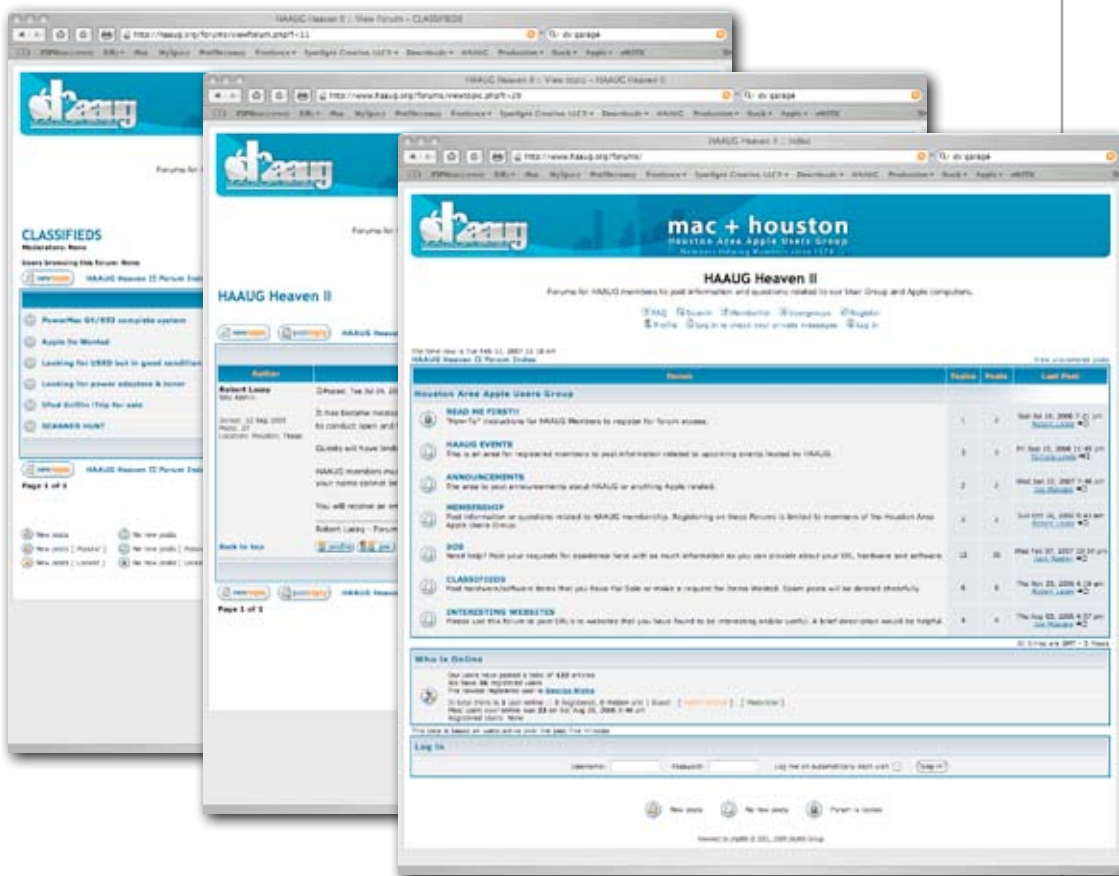

Minutes

HAAUG Board of Director's Meeting - Tuesday, October 7, 2008

Location: Industrial Audio/Video, Inc., 2617 Bissonnet, Houston, Texas.

Attendees: Philip Booth, Jim Connell, Rex Covington, David Crook, Jeff Davis, Michael Epstein, Clair Jaschke, David Jaschke, Barbara Long (via iChat), Joe Muscara, Rick Roberts, Doug Smith (via iChat) and Matt Willmore.

Call to order: 6:37 p.m. by President Philip Booth, a quorum of voting board members being present for the meeting.

General Announcements/General Meeting Recap: The September General Meeting scheduled for Saturday, September 20, 2008, was cancelled because members were dealing with lack of electricity and other storm-related issues in the aftermath of Hurricane Ike, which struck the Houston area on September 13, 2008.

MONTHLY REPORTS:

Secretary – Jim Connell: The minutes of the board meeting held on September 2, 2008, were unanimously approved with one correction.

Treasurer – Barbara Long: There were no Boutique sales in September. All bills have been paid, and all funds during the month received have been deposited. At the end of September, HAAUG had a bank balance of \$8,972.19, a month-to-date profit of \$286.86, and a year-to-date loss of \$1,677.18. Phil requested that the Audit Committee meet during the week of October 20 to complete the audit of HAAUG's books. He will notify the committee members of the meeting date.

HAAUG's bank account is held at Washington Mutual, which the FDIC seized in late September. JP Morgan Chase has assumed Washington Mutual's deposit accounts, including HAAUG's bank account. The funds in the account are FDIC-insured and fully available.

1st Vice President – Doug Smith: Bob LeVitus can attend the General Meeting on October 18. Doug Smith will determine Bob LeVitus's availability, if the General Meeting is moved to October 25. Otherwise, Bob LeVitus will be available for the November General Meeting. The presentation on Microsoft Office can be given at the October General Meeting, if the meeting is moved to October 25 and Bob LeVitus cannot attend on that date.

2nd Vice President – Matt Willmore: Phil Booth reported that the Bellaire Civic Center is not available to HAAUG on Saturday, October 18, but has been reserved for HAAUG on Saturday, October 25. David Crook advised that the Fellowship Hall at Presbyterian Church on South Rice Ave. near the Bellaire Civic Center is available on October 18, for a fee of \$90. The board discussed the pros and cons of holding the General Meeting on a date other than the third Saturday of the month. After discussion, the Board approved moving the date of the October General Meeting from Saturday, October 18, 2008, to Saturday, October 25, 2008, so that the meeting

can be held at the Bellaire Civic Center.

Rick Roberts reported that the management of the Rice Media Center is not willing to allow HAAUG to meet there because no employee of the Media Center is available to unlock and lock the building and monitor its use on Saturdays. Rick will explore the possibility of meeting at the Rice Theatre, which is adjacent to the Mudd Computer Science Laboratory on the Rice Campus. The north parking lot, which has credit card access, is just north of the building.

SIG Coordinator – Rick Roberts: No changes on the SIG schedule are planned for the October General Meeting. Rick will send out a PDF of the SIG schedule. Clair will lead the Quicken SIG at the October General Meeting.

Apple Barrel Editor – Joe Muscara: No report.

Webmaster – Jeff Davis: The servers were offline for a total of three hours during Hurricane Ike. As a result of the hurricane, several members who are authorized to make changes to the HAAUG website were without electricity. The board discussed the need for more members to have access to the website in such circumstances. To make changes to the website, a member must have the Adobe Dreamweaver software program and authorization to access the website. Phil will ask for volunteers at the next General Meeting.

Membership – David Jaschke: At the end of August, HAAUG had 242 members, down from 251 in August 2007. Two new members joined in August, and eleven members renewed their membership, including two 2-year renewals. HAAUG also had 242 members at the end of September, a decrease of twelve members from September 2007. Two new members also joined in September. Five members renewed their membership, including two 2-year renewals. More new members might have joined in September if the General Meeting had not been cancelled.

HAAUG Heaven Forum/HAAUGNet—No report.

Old Business: None

New Business:

30th Anniversary Celebration: The celebration, which was scheduled for the September General Meeting, had to be cancelled due to the aftermath of Hurricane Ike. Depending upon the availability of Bob LeVitus, the celebration will be rescheduled for the October or November General Meeting.

Nominations Committee: The committee is looking for members to serve in officer and director positions for next year and will report at the November General Meeting.

Budget Committee: Phil will appoint a committee to prepare the 2009 budget before the November General Meeting.
